Regarding Temporary Closure Orders TC4444 (Footpaths 30 and 31, Old Bolsover Parish) and TC4443 (part of Footpath 33, Old Bolsover Parish), and any related correspondence:

1. The total number of emails received by Derbyshire County Council objecting to, or raising concerns about, these temporary closures and/or the associated proposed diversions, between 1 May 2026 and the date of this request.

It is not actually possible to object to a Temporary Closure, as there is no facility for public consultation. All of the customers have received a full response explaining this. None of the enquiries therefore qualify as formal objections, even if the words 'I object' have been used. With that in mind, the number of emails received, from people wanting to complain about the closure, was 54.

2. The total number of emails received in support of the closures/diversions over the same period, if any were logged as such.

No emails were received showing support for the closure, but as it was not a public consultation, we would not expect to receive any.

3. Whether any of the objection emails referenced in point 1 were later withdrawn, and if so, how many.

As it was not a public consultation, there were no formal objections to be withdrawn. However, none of the customers have asked us to disregard their email following receipt of our response.
